Sending cat's entry on-line or by email is equivalent with an acceptance of processing and publication of personal data by the organizer of the show – SMK Żory. Personal data will be published in a show catalogue.

Advertising in a catalogue: 1 page – 25 EUR; ½ page – 15 EUR

After submitting the entry form and placing the cat in the catalog, the Exhibitor is obliged to pay the cat fee, whether or not a cat will be attended (FIFe Exhibit Rules - Chapter I.1.15 a). Exhibitors submitting to the cat by fax or letter should ensure that the application has been received.

Show rules: All FIFe show rules are valid and applicable. Exhibitors may present the cat to the judges themselves. **Please notice: CAT SHOULD BE TAKEN TO THE CAT RING ONLY IN A CONVEYOR !EVERY EXHIBITOR WILL HAVE HIS PERSONAL CAT TOY** (given by Organizer) which should be taken to the ring. Exhibition cats should be kept in decorated cages during all time- it is not allowed to keep a cat on the top of a cage. All cages will be numbered, which cannot be changed by Exhibitor. Participation is at risk of the exhibitor, no claims for damages will be accepted. All changes in classes must be announced to the show secretariat until 10:00 am. It is not allowed to leave the exhibition before The Best in Show Panel. Certificates will be ready after the Best in Show - according to the FIFe Exhibitions Regulations, ch. I no 1.15, c)

Veterinary rules:

The cats have been vaccinated by a veterinarian in accordance with each country's veterinary regulations, against feline panleucopenia, feline calicivirus and feline herpesvirus, and have had the required boosters, at least 21 days prior to the show. The period of the validity for the vaccination is marked by the veterinary surgeon in the pet passport or on the vaccination certificate. Vaccination against rabies is to be according to national legislation - all cats living outside of Poland must be vaccinated against rabies. White cats must have a certificate stating that they are not deaf.
